Spotlight Session 1: CTAC Mapping Tool

An overview of the mapping tool was demonstrated. Network members were invited to discuss:

We asked members, What was your key learning/lightbulb moment in 2023?

- Staff picked up a DVT while patient was in for something else. That holistic care isn't lost in this model of care.
- A patient who had been having leg ulcer treatments was moved to treatment room and has now been discharged.
- Work done to implement CDM across the service is working well.
- Higher management are getting positive patient feedback letters about how well we're delivering.
