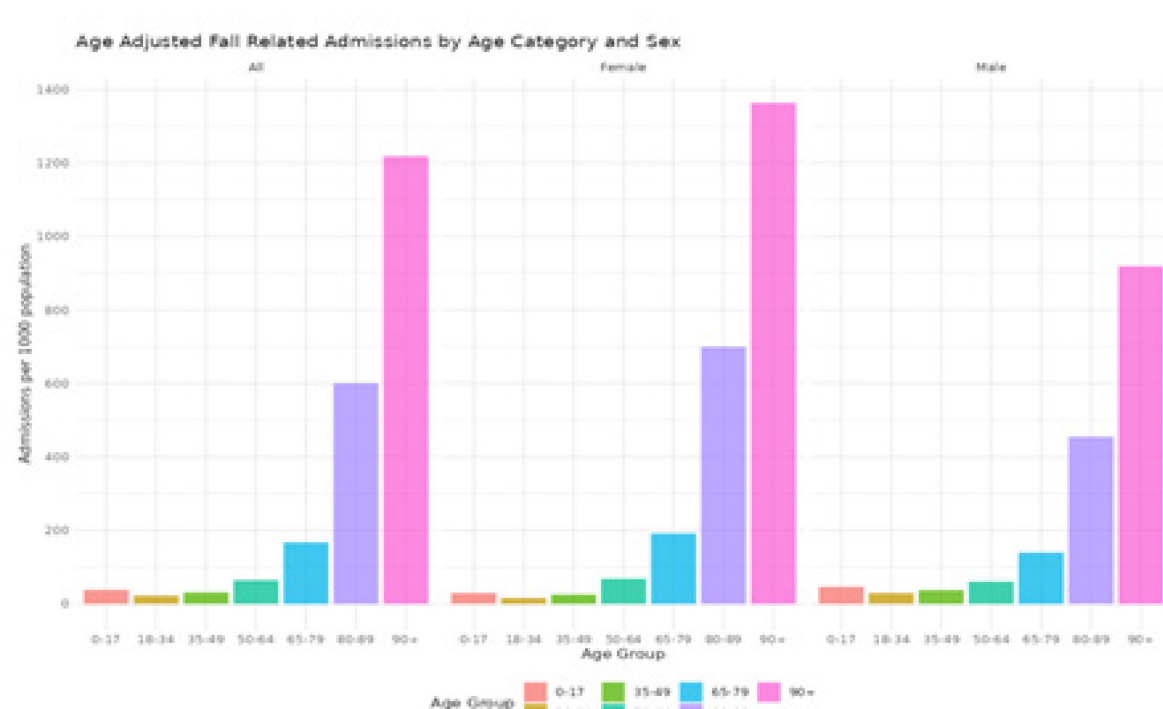
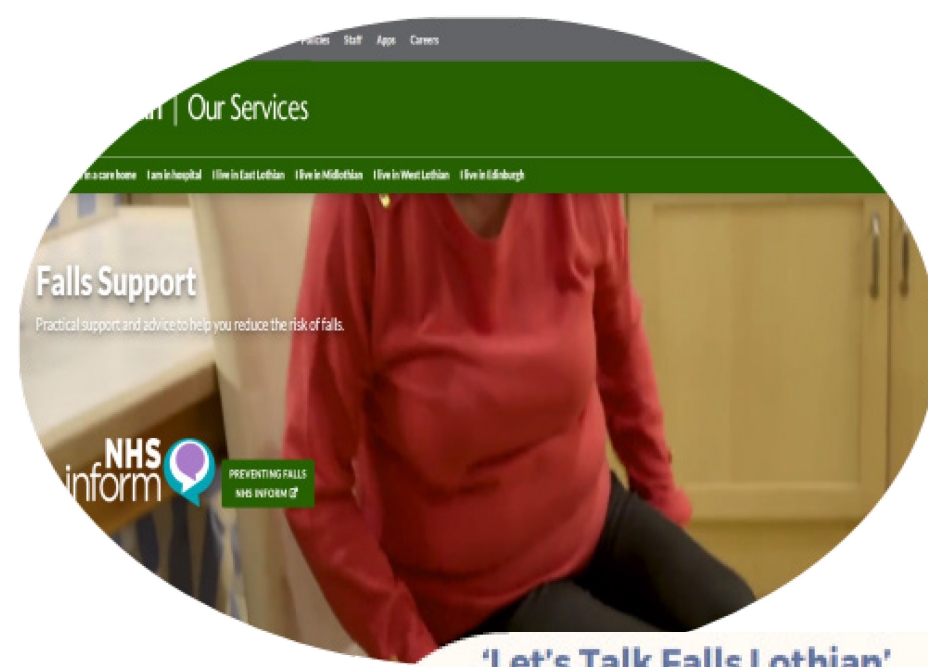
To reduce inpatient falls by 20% and falls with harm by 30% within the NHS Lothian Acute Adult sites by March 2024

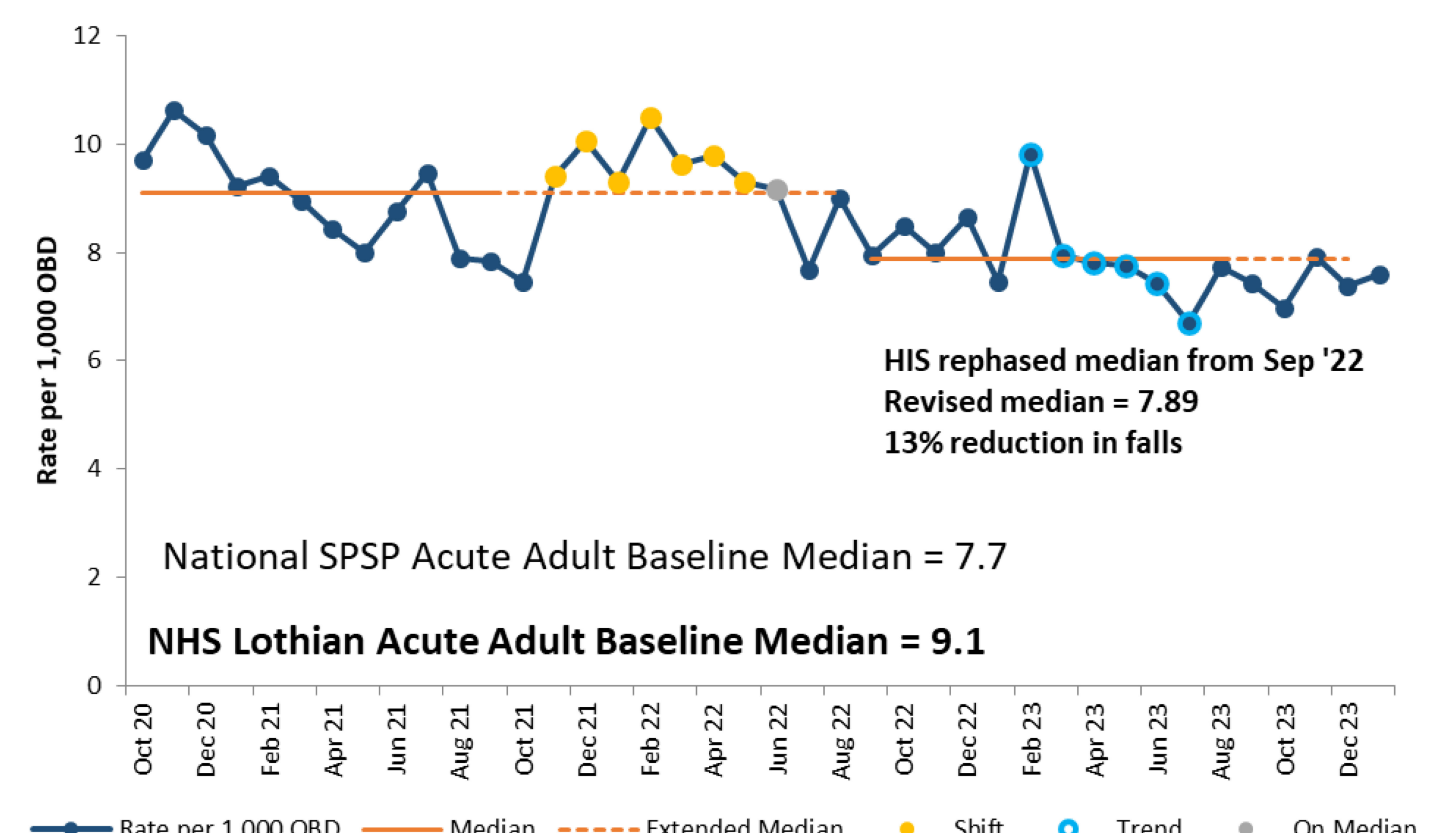
