

SPSP Medicines WebEx Series 2018/2019

Following on from a successful second series of WebExes in 2017/2018, and based on feedback from boards we are pleased to be hosting a third series of WebExes for 2018/19.

The WebExes are open to all who are interested in medicines safety, including NHS boards in Scotland, Health and Social Care Partnerships, Public Partners and Service users. The third series will continue to promote learning and sharing on topics relating to reducing medicines harm across transitions, omitted medicines and high risk medicines from a whole system perspective. Each month, participants will hear from different teams in Scotland, teams outside Scotland or the SPSP medicines team. Participants will also have the opportunity to reflect on their local experiences and contribute to the general discussion and question time after the presentations.
