BounceOT (bOunceT)



Callum MacKinnon, Founder & Specialist Occupational Therapist, BounceOT (bOunceT)

Having changed my degree at University from International Business to Occupational Therapy in 2013, after working abroad at a disability summer camp in USA, I started working as a Personal Assistant with ENABLE Scotland. I primarily worked in Children & Young People's Services across Forth Valley until I graduated as an Occupational Therapist in 2017.

I initially set up what is now BounceOT – a 7 day per week disability service in Stirling – as a small project that I ran on weekends once I graduated University. Thanks to generous support from business support agencies, and funders across the voluntary sector, I was able to transition into running BounceOT full time and build a team. We turned 5 years old as a Community Interest Company in April 2022 and hope to celebrate another 5 more (at least)! The next steps for BounceOT is to not only increase our social impact across Forth Valley, but to replicate via a social model – similar to Talking Mats. We hope to test the effectiveness of licensing a training programme and offer 'bOunceT in a box' – a new franchise initiative.

Alongside running my social enterprise full time, I have participated in further study as a Postgraduate level to further develop my clinical skills. To date, I have certified as a Sensory Integration Practitioner, and I am in the final stages of completing the necessary modules to obtain an MSc Advancing Practice in Occupational Therapy.



Mission:


To improve the quality of life and participation in meaningful occupations for children and adults with disabilities, and their family, in Scotland.

"play as an occupation: play as an aim, play as a right, and play for participation"


